

# NORTH STAR CAMP STAFF PACKING LIST

This list is to help staff members pack and prepare for camp. If you have any questions, please contact the office at office@northstarcamp.com or message the staff WhatsApp group.

- North Star does not have a uniform policy. You are allowed to wear clothing that you are comfortable in as long as it is appropriate for a children's summer camp. Any clothing depicting alcohol, drugs, tobacco or sexual content is strictly prohibited.
- Every staff member will receive 1 North Star Staff
   T-Shirt which we will ask you to wear on certain days each session.
- Laundry occurs once a week, so pack for around 10 days worth of clothes (a few extra days just in case).
  - All clothes should be labeled with permanent marker so they don't end up in the Lost & Found.







#### Weather at camp

- Daytime temps average between 70-85°F (21-29°C)
- Evening temps average between 55-65°F (12-18°C)

  It can get even cooler in May and August,

  so be prepared to layer!
