For those of you outside of the Chicago area and Wisconsin, we are sending one email to highlight some key travel details. We are condensing this into a single email, so please familiarize yourself with:

- Some basic travel info for those flying to camp
- · Baggage options, including utilizing Shipcamps
- Hotel room block for anyone opting to have their camper travel through Chicago

Flying to Camp

We have two pages on the North Star website that will detail travel to and from camp.

- The Travel to Camp page explains the different options for getting your camper to camp.
- The Air Travel Page goes into more detail about the flying, unaccompanied minor programs and our partnership with Travel One. It also lists flights we ask families to book, by city.

Please help us out by familiarizing yourself with North Star's travel procedures. This will help ensure as smooth of a travel day as possible for our group.

Camper Baggage/Shipcamps

The baggage page on our website details the options for getting your camper's bags between your home and camp.

Many of our families outside of Chicago, Milwaukee and Minneapolis opt to ship their camper's bags to camp. Shipping bags to camp can save you money, avoid lots of hassles, and it allows our staff to focus their energy on your camper at the airport.

We highly recommend campers flying to camp utilize our partnership with the company Shipcamps to ship camper baggage to and from camp. While there is a cost associated with the service, airlines are increasing their baggage fees each year, particularly for large duffle bags. Some families are paying a few hundred dollars per bag to check camp bags on their camper's flight.

If you prefer to deal directly with FedEx or UPS to ship bags to camp, you can go that route, however we believe that Shipcamps will provide the best rate due to their bulk discount.

Shipcamps will be the only option for those who choose to have bags shipped home at the end of your

camper's session.

Chicago Area Hotel Block

Some families outside of the Chicago area opt to have their camper take the bus from Chicago to camp. These buses depart at 8:15am from the Renaissance Chicago North Shore Hotel. For the families who need to stay overnight in Chicago the night before departure day, we have partnered with the hotel to arrange a group room block rate of \$129/night plus taxes. You can book a room at the links here:

- Second Session Saturday July 12 to Sunday July 13 Book A Room Here (must book by 6/14)
