The last of the North Star online forms have been activated in the CampInTouch online portal for parents (and campers) to review and complete.

The additional forms that have been added include:

- Camper Profile
- Camper Questionnaire
- Review of and agreement to North Star's Code of Conduct

These remaining forms, listed above, are due for all campers by June 1st. (All medical and transportation forms that have been open and active for some time now are due completed by May 1st.)

### Camp forms can also be submitted directly from our app, CAMPANION

North Star uses Companion as a mobile friendly way for you to fill out your camp forms, see pictures and send emails to your camper while they are in-session.

If you haven't already, follow these three simple steps to get started:

- **Download the Companion app**
- **Login** to the app using this email address and password (the same you created during registration and the same you use on your desktop)
- **Upload** a reference photo of your child (this will allow you to get direct notifications of when new pictures are posted of your camper in the summer)



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### **A few notes about the additional camp forms:**

Camp forms provide an opportunity for you to tell us more about your camper before the summer begins. If you have a new camper, do your best to describe them to the best of your ability, so we can set them up for success. If you have a returning camper (and you've filled out these forms in the past) remember that they continue to change and grow and they will have a new group of counselors who do not know them.

As always, be open, honest and forthcoming. If it's been a tough year for any sort of reason, do your best to explain why. If school or different life circumstances have been challenging, share those details with us, so we can make sure we set up the needed levels of support in order for North Star to continue to be a place and space that is safe and feels good for everyone.

#### **The Camper Profile Form**

This form is filled out by you, the parent or guardian. It's your opportunity to describe your child, describe the ways that they are successful and the ways they are navigating challenges currently. It's your opportunity to share pertinent information with the camp directors and camp counselors before the session begins. (If you have notes that need to be shared with the nurses and Health Center staff, make sure those get recorded on your camper's Health History form, not the Camper Profile.)

#### **The Camper Questionnaire Form**

This form gets completed by your camper. It's their opportunity to share their own feelings, goals and reflections before camp starts.

#### **Review and Agreement of North Star's Code of Conduct**

We want you take time with your camper to sit down and fully review the [North Star Code of Conduct](#) together.

At camp, North Star will teach campers:

- To recognize that they have responsibility for themselves and those around them.
- To learn to make choices which are good for themselves and others, and to take responsibility for the choices they make.
- To respect oneself and others, despite differences.
- To accept that they are accountable for their actions and the consequences for inappropriate behaviors.

It is crucial that you discuss the [North Star Code of Conduct](#) directly with your camper, which includes rules and expectations for behavior and actions. Knowing your own child best, discuss these expectations at a level that they can comprehend. Use our Code of Conduct as a tool to learn more from your camper about what they have already heard, experienced and learned. We strive to positively influence all campers so they can become the best version of themselves and our Code of Conduct aims to help by clearly defining boundaries and expectations for their own behavior during the summer and beyond.

Sign the acknowledgement to our Code of Conduct (in the online CampInTouch portal) after you have this conversation with them to acknowledge that everyone is in agreement.

We know there are a lot of camp forms to complete and many things to do between now and the start of camp. We appreciate your partnership and all of the work you are already doing to get your camper ready to set them up for success. We can't wait for a great 81st summer at North Star together.
